Clifford S. Mitchell, MS, MD, MPH is the Director of the Environmental Health Bureau, in the Prevention and Health Promotion Administration, Maryland Department of Health. The Bureau's responsibilities include: food protection; environmental, occupational, and injury epidemiology; and an array of healthy homes and injury prevention programs. He joined the Department in 2006, after 14 years on the faculty of the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health. Dr. Mitchell received a B.A. from Williams College, an M.S. from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, an M.D. degree from Case Western Reserve University, and his M.P.H. from the Johns Hopkins School of Hygiene and Public Health. Dr. Mitchell is Principal Investigator for several projects in the Department, including climate change, environmental public health tracking, occupational injury and illness surveillance, violent death surveillance, and the Office of Food Protection Rapid Response Team. He serves on several state and national environmental health advisory committees, and has contributed to peer-reviewed publications and reports in the fields of environmental and occupational health, surveillance, and workforce development.
